




Call for Youth Workers

**Euro-Mediterranean youth work for
Intercultural democratic citizenship
Preventing Polarisation**



ABOUT THE PROJECT

The long term project includes a 10-month programme directed towards the capacity building and competence development of youth work professionals, youth leaders, community mediators and educators (from formal and non-formal sectors) that are directly working at the local level with groups of young people addressing extreme polarisation dynamics.

OUTCOMES OF THE PROJECT

The Project will support youth workers and educators to:

- Develop competences to prevent polarisation based on the principles of intercultural democratic citizenship and human rights education;
- Analyse the role of youth work addressing the causes, consequences and dynamics of polarisation and exchanging practices and methodologies on how to prevent it;
- Prepare initiatives contributing to prevent polarisation in the local communities and develop cooperation strategies in the Euro-Mediterranean area.

Trajectorya MTÜ is a Youth Training NGO based in Tallinn founded in 2005



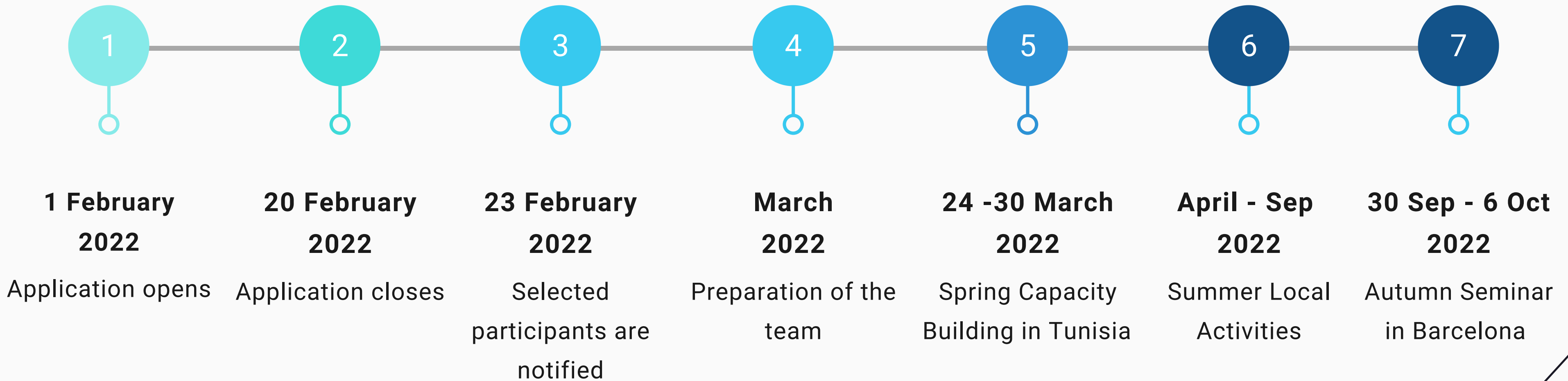
Association of Human Rights Educators - AHEAD is an NGO based in Barcelona, founded in 2009

ELIGIBILITY

Attending youth workers are required to :

- Demonstrate engagement in community youth work
- Be ready to identify and address polarisation issues in the community
- Be fluent in written and spoken English
- Commitment to attend the 6-day Spring Training Course in Tunisia and the 6 - day Autumn Seminar in Barcelona
- Commitment to undertake local projects preventing polarisation in coordination with the coordinator organisations.
- Commit to consistent communication with the mentoring team for the whole duration of the programme.

The programme costs including tuition, materials, accommodation, food and the 80% of the travel costs are covered by the organisers. There is a participation fee of 45€ for EU participants.



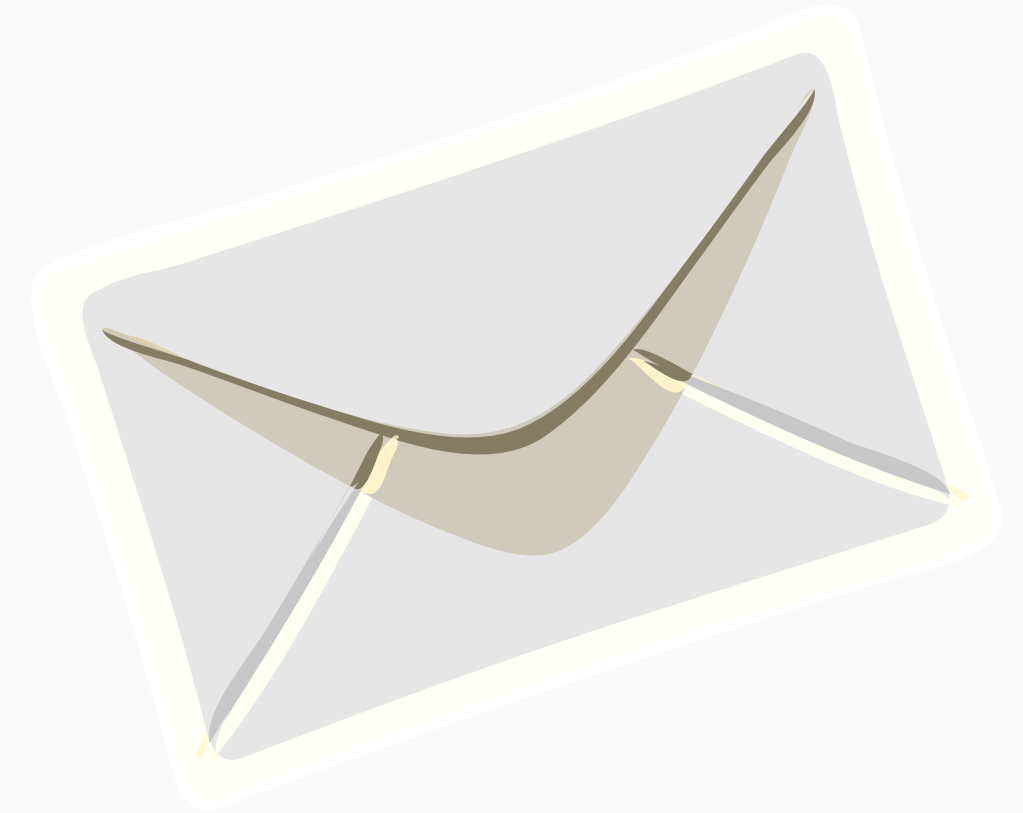
